What is **AFIX**?






- Launched in 2012 at AfPIF in Johannesburg
 - Member of the Internet eXchange Federation (IX-F) since 2014
- Currently 45 IXPs in 41 cities in 33 countries
 - Oldest: JINX (1996)
 - Newest: Somalia, Zanzibar
- We host bi-annual meetings at AIS and AfPIF
- We host a private mailing list for IXP operators
- We research and publish data about our region

African IXPs: Survey Response Rates





Growth in Africa




African IXPs: Total Number of Active IXPs by Year


- Conservative figures

- Inconsistent accounting of traffic statistics
- Some samples include significant transit traffic

African IXPs: Peak Traffic - Distribution in 2018 (in Gbps)




- Nearly universal growth, but uneven distribution
- Largest was ~480G
- Approximately half carry less than 1 Gbps



- Largest had 302



Membership Composition




African IXPs: Regional Membership Composition


African IXPs: Governing Entity Types




- Government IXPs had lowest average annual growth rates:
 - 91 Mbps
 - 1 network
- For-profit IXPs had the highest average annual growth rates:
 - 20 Gbps
 - 19 networks





African IXPs: % of IXPs w/ Recurring Donations (2018)




- 59% of IXPs receive recurring donations

African IXPs: % of IXPs w/ Donations in Last 12 Months (2018)




- 59% of IXPs receive recurring donations






African IXPs: Paid and Volunteer Staffing in 2018


